Term	Topic Titles	Brief Overview
<b>1</b>	Einwanderung	Students learn how to explain the main reasons why people migrate, evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of immigration for immigrants and the country of destination and examine the issues affecting a country's migration policy
	Deutschland und die Europäische Union	Students learn how to discuss how the EU has evolved and Germany's role within it, the advantages and disadvantages of the EU for Germany and to understand the impact of EU expansion on Germany
<b>2</b>	Integration	Students learn how to discuss how the German government promotes the integration of migrants and refugees, elements which prevent integration and to compare the positive and negative experiences of migrants and refugees in Germany
	Die Politik und die Jugend	Students learn how to discuss the ways and the extent to which young people engage in politics, priorities for youth politics in Germany, the priorities of young people and the role of pressure groups
	Rassismus	Students learn how to discuss the impact of racism on its victims and the support available, the origins of racism and how people resist racism and show moral courage to fight against it
	Die Wiedervereinigung und ihre Folgen	Students learn how to discuss the events and developments which led to German reunification, to contrast the desired and actual outcomes of the reunification and to compare the culture and identity of the old and new federal states
<b>3</b>	Revision and exam skills	Students put the content they have learnt into practice in exam-style questions.
