This cohort's hard work and commitment have truly paid off with an excellent set of examination results. With an incredible 39.7% of all grades awarded at Grade 7-9, school performance is well above the national figure of 21.8%. This remarkable achievement reflects the relentless determination and effort our students have shown throughout their studies.

Equally impressive is the 76.9% of grades awarded at grade 5-9 and 82.2% of grades awarded at grades 4-9 – again well above the national figure of 67.6%, highlighting the broad success across the entire year group.
