We have had tremendous success with student outcomes within Economics using the same platform provider, and they have offered the school a fantastic deal across all of their subjects.

Up Learn have agreed to very generously provide all Year 13 students who study the above subjects a free license to use their platform for the remainder of Year 13.

The site provides the following:

- **Comprehensive course structure** – the whole A Level course broken down into individual sections.
- **In-depth exam preparation** – there are whole sections dedicated to helping students master their exams. This also includes exam technique, walk-throughs and exclusive examiner-written papers from the exam boards relevant to the above subjects here at Arden
- **AI adaptive algorithms** – these algorithms identify students strengths and weaknesses, testing them repeatedly until they score 100% through improved recall
- **Student tracking tools** – students (and teachers) have access to an online dashboard, which demonstrates their progress
